

WELCOME COCKTAIL

El Salão Árabe is one of the city's most important architectural attractions.

- ◆ The **Palácio da Bolsa** (Stock Exchange Palace) is a neoclassical style and historical building in Porto. The palace was built in the 19th century.
- ◆ The highlight of this place is the **Salão Árabe** (Arabian Room) a beautiful gilded ballroom decorated in Moorish Revival style, an amazing combination of western and eastern influences which will take your breath away.
- ◆ The Arabian Room is the most important hall for official events in the city of Porto and is mainly used for major events, such as events and official receptions.
- ◆ This is a very important space for the history of Porto and Portugal, since the Agreement on the European Economic Area was signed in this room.

The building, whose configuration resembles the moorings of the boats to the quays, combines with its avant-garde shape a coating inspired by one of the most traditional Portuguese decorative materials: the tile.



One million tiles, produced by the historic porcelain factory of "Vista Alegre", cover the structure of the building and allow a curious play of lights throughout the day.




Capable of receiving the most modern and gigantic cruise vessels, the Terminal is one of the main tourist entrances in the region.

A National Monument along the bank of the Douro River

The Porto Customshouse Congress Centre (*Centro de Congressos da Alfândega*) is a convention centre and former customs, built during the 14th century, the only official building of the Portuguese royalty in the city at that time. It is also known as the Casa do Infante, as it was where Henry the Navigator, patron of the Portuguese discoveries, was born.
- 

The building was designed to be practical and modern in its days. It even has a railway line that connected it to the railway station of Campanhã in Porto. The side facing the river, which can be well appreciated in Vila Nova de Gaia, was prepared to receive all the merchants that arrived by ship.
- 

After the opening of Leixões port, further north of Porto, the merchant ships no longer need to sail up the Douro, so the customs closed its doors and moved to Leixões.

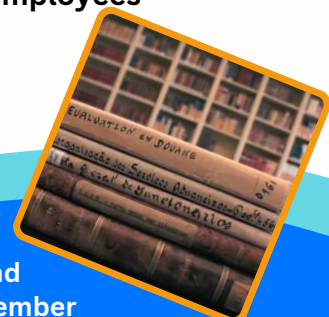
The museum and library is located inside the Porto Customshouse Congress Centre. The Customs Museum exhibits diverse documentation, equipment and instruments used in the Customs House Treasuries, Warehouses, Dispatches, Laboratories, as well as objects related to and used by the Customs employees
